Position Title: Seasonal Community Worker III (3 positions)

Facility: Sand Lake Tribal Community/Center

Job Family: Community Comp Grade: G-2 (DOQ Starting \$15.05) Status: FT

Position Summary:

This position provides an opportunity to learn and apply basic wood cutting and minor construction practices.

Essential Functions:

Clearing down timber and generating firewood for wood-burning heating systems for community members. Maintenance duties necessary to assist community center and members with general upkeep. Maintain community members homes, driveways, and sidewalks during the winter season. Assisting with general carpentry duties at the direction of the Tribal Administrator.

Community Worker Duties:

- Maintenance duties both indoors and outdoors;
- Cutting grass and clearing brush to maintain area;
- Clearing, cutting, and splitting wood;
- Operating dangerous equipment such as chainsaws and splitters;
- Operating heavy equipment such as plow truck or snow blower;
- Inventory, track, and maintain equipment;
- Learn and apply all safety practices;
- All and any other duties assigned by supervisor.
