Position Summary: The position provides the opportunity to learn and apply basic residential construction practices.

Essential Functions: Build new residential homes and perform various maintenance tasks on tribally owned properties.

Job Duties:

- Learn and perform various residential construction related tasks.
- Learn and perform rough carpentry tasks.
- Learn and apply exterior finishes; various siding, roofing, doors, windows and accessories installation.
- Learn and apply safe building practices.
- Any other duties assigned by supervisor

- Must have a valid driver's license and must be insurable.
